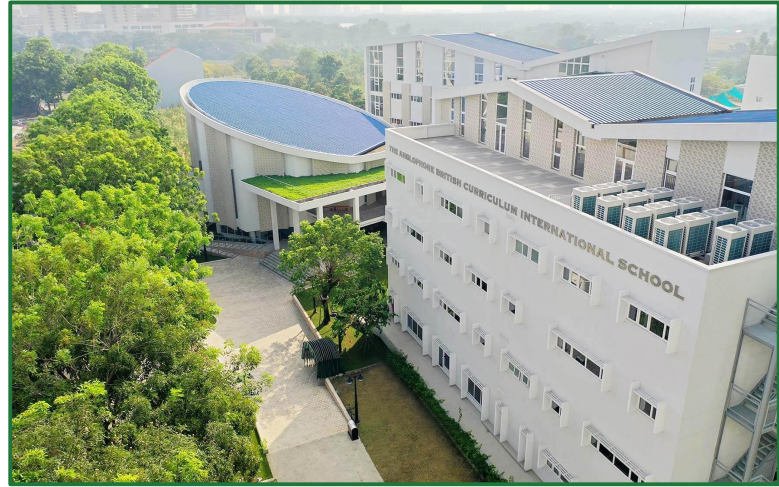

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Year 2 to Year 3 Handover Process

Teacher Handover: Our teachers meet to share important information so that each child feels known, supported, and confident moving into Year 3.

Continuous Collaboration: Although we are across two campuses, we work closely together as one EY and Primary team, making it easy to connect and collaborate whenever needed throughout the year.

Familiar Faces: With familiar adults working across both campuses, children continue to see trusted faces and benefit from strong relationships as they move into Year 3.

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A Gentle, Familiar Start

Morning Welcomes: Teachers meet the children every morning and guide them up to their classrooms to start the day together.

Snack and Play Times: Your child's teacher will accompany them to help them manage their money, buy snacks, and help with which areas of the playground they are playing in.

End of Day Routine: Teachers will bring the children directly to the buses or the front steps. Children will wear stickers so that they and all adults always know exactly where they need to go.

ECAs: Children will have stickers and will be dropped off at the exact classroom for their activity.

Independence: This will be a gradual approach, we will gently ease the children into new responsibilities when they are ready.

By having separate lunch and playtimes from the older secondary pupils, Key Stage 2 children are given a safe, secure environment where they can play with their friends.

Seamless Transitions, Familiar Spaces

By grouping Key Stage 2 classrooms together, children enjoy a secure, familiar space.

When it is time for a specialist lesson, their teacher will pick them up just like in Key Stage 1, making every transition easy.
