What Can You Expect in Pre-Nursery/ Nursery?

Welcome to Pre-Nursery and Nursery! This is the exciting start of your child's learning journey!

In our safe and caring classroom, children learn through fun play, sensory activities, and hands-on exploration that build curiosity and creativity. We focus on strong foundations: helping your child feel happy, make wonderful first friends, and grow in confidence every day. Step-by-step, your child will learn to express their feelings, make play choices, and build independence in caring for themselves and our school community.



What Will Your Child Learn This Year?

Prime Areas



Communication and Language

We are so excited to help your child grow as a confident speaker and listener! Through interactive story times, carpet games, and active play, children will learn to listen carefully, follow simple instructions, and share their ideas using words and gestures. We will expand their vocabulary every day with fun, hands-on activities that encourage them to start conversations, ask questions, and take turns talking with new friends!



Personal, Social and Emotional Development

Your child's happiness and emotional well-being are at the heart of everything we do! In our classroom, we focus on building confidence, independence, and strong, happy friendships every single day. To help children understand and talk about their feelings, we use simple, colourful pictures through the "Zones of Regulation" programme. The children will discover simple ways to help themselves feel calm and ready to play.



Physical Development

We support your child in building a strong, healthy body, physical confidence, and essential self-care skills! Through energetic games, outdoor exploration, and hands-on play, we will help them develop big movement skills (gross motor) like balancing, climbing, and running safely. We will also strengthen their small hand muscles (fine motor) using fun tools like playdough, scissors, and paintbrushes so they are ready for early drawing and writing.

What Will Your Child Learn This Year?

Specific Areas



Literacy

We are so excited to encourage your child's love for books and stories! Together, we will share fun picture books and non-fiction texts to build early reading habits. Children will learn how books work—like holding them correctly and turning pages one by one—while listening for fun sounds, rhythm, and rhyme!



Mathematics

We cannot wait to help your child explore numbers, shapes, and patterns through fun, hands-on play! We will build early maths skills by counting, sorting, measuring, and discovering shapes in our environment. Using storybooks like *We're Going on a Bear Hunt* and *Goldilocks and the Three Bears*, children will practice counting objects, recognising amounts, comparing sizes (like big and small), and using position words like "over" and "under"!

What Will Your Child Learn This Year?



Understanding the World

We encourage the children to be curious and have wonders through hands-on experiences that support your child to explore nature and learn about the world around them! Through sensory play, children will explore natural materials, discover how living things grow, and learn about different weather and seasons. They will also share stories about their families, discover different roles in our community, and build positive, respectful attitudes towards others.



Expressive Arts and Design

We develop opportunities for you child to unleash their creativity, imagination, and self-expression through art, music, movement, and role-play! The children will explore primary colours and discover the magic of paint mixing, work together to create projects, and play with natural textures like mud, grass, and water. They will also bring stories to life by acting out scenes from *Goldilocks and the Three Bears* using bowls, spoons, and chairs!

Teaches Learners To...

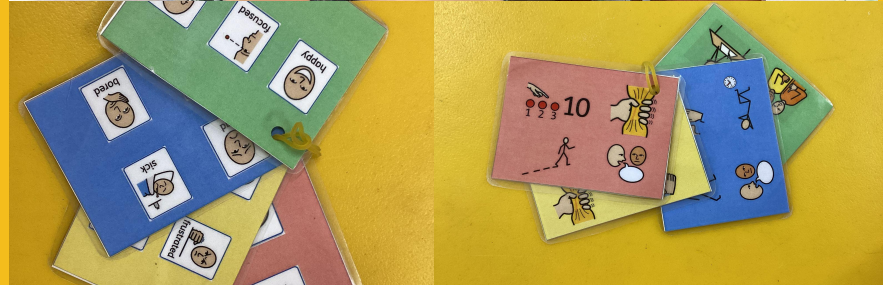
- Identify feelings, energy and levels of alertness

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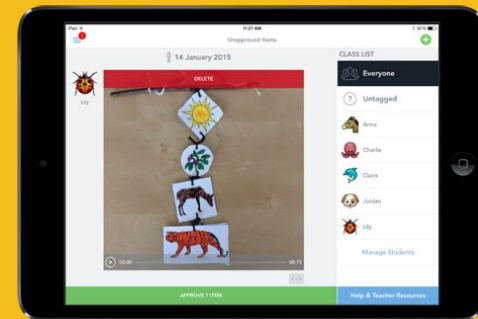
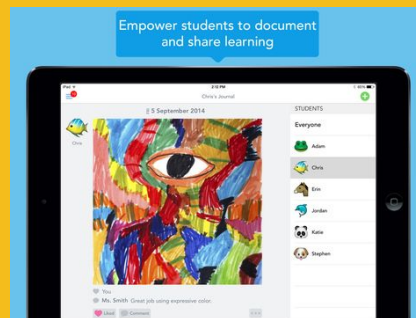
Stay Connected with Seesaw

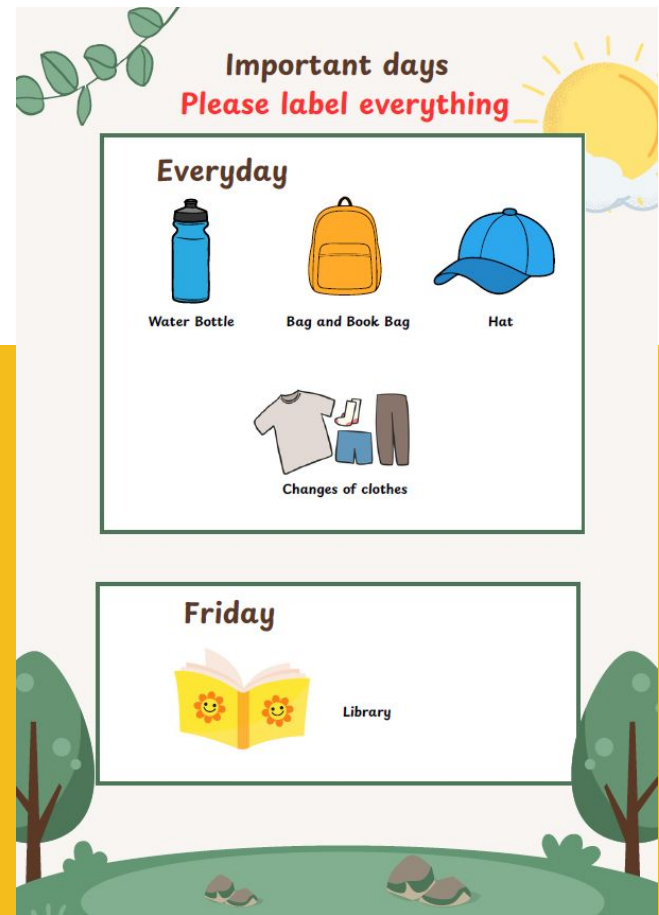


Daily Routines

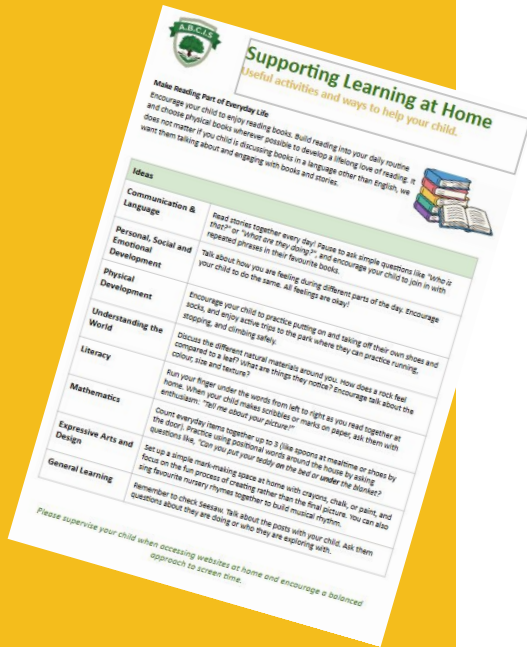
What Trips and Special Experiences Will Your Child Have?
