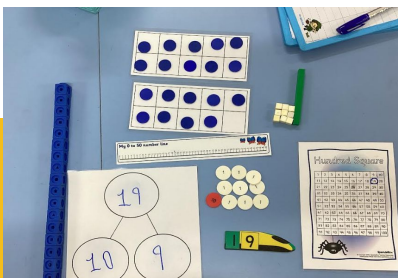
What Will Your Child Learn This Year?

Core Subjects



English

This year, your child's English journey takes off in incredible ways. Having built strong roots through phonics, they will now dive into exciting storybooks, poetry, and real-world texts. They will learn to read with smooth fluency and write their own imaginative stories with growing confidence. Every page they read and every sentence they craft brings them one step closer to becoming powerful communicators ready for Key Stage 2.



Maths

We start by exploring how numbers work—how tens and units fit together like puzzle pieces.

Later in the year, we will unlock the magic of multiplication and division! Best of all, your child will get to join the thrilling world of Times Tables Rockstars, a fun game that turns learning times tables into a fast-paced, challenge they will absolutely love.

Maths in Year 2 is so much more than just numbers on a page—it is hands-on, visual, and practical. Every single lesson helps them see that maths is a super-power they can use in everyday life, building the confidence they need to tackle any challenge with a big smile!



Science

Science in Year 2 is all about getting hands-on, asking big "why" questions, and making sense of the amazing world around us.

Your child won't just learn about science—they will do science, through exciting topics such as Materials, Animals including Humans and Plants! Together, we will make exciting predictions, set up fun experiments, and discover what happens when we test our ideas. They will learn to observe closely, sort their findings like real researchers, and proudly share their discoveries with their classmates.

Humanities & Languages

- **History** - Get ready for incredible journeys back in time! Your child will uncover the dramatic story of the Great Fire of London and set off on exciting adventures with history's greatest explorers. They will also meet inspiring, brave women like Emily Davison and Malala Yousafzai, learning how ordinary people can change the world.
- **Geography** - Geography takes your child on a journey around the globe! They will explore the mountains, cities, and landmarks of the United Kingdom and learn all about our planet's seven huge continents and five vast oceans. Best of all, they will connect their learning to home by comparing life in the UK with life right here in Vietnam.

Creative & Digital
